### RULES

The regatta will be sailed under the 2001 to 2004 International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) the prescriptions of SAS and the rules of the individual classes except where amended by the sailing instructions.

### ELIGIBILITY & CLASSES

All boats 28' and up are legible to sail. A minimum of five boats constitutes a class.

Racing class & a cruising class (no spinnakers).
