### Notice of Race

#### **Event.**

The sailing development regatta will be held from 10 October to the 12 October 2003.

#### **Venue**

The Sailing Center, Simon'sberg Naval Base, Simon's Town

#### **Boats and equipment**

1. Bosun class yachts will be used for the championship, with sails and equipment and supplied by the Navy. A boat will be issued to competitors for each race or for a number of races in accordance with the sailing instructions.
2. The use of a boat may be withdrawn if, in the opinion of the organising authority, a competitor treats or handles a boat without care or in a manner, which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat.

3. The boats may not be modified in any way except for the following:
  - tying of yarn or thread wind indicators anywhere on the boat provided their fitting does not pierce or damage the hull, deck, sails or spars.
  - taping or tying of water bottles into the cockpit
4. Failure of supplied equipment will not be grounds for redress.
5. Competitors may wear their own lifejackets. Lifejackets will be provided for competitors who don't bring their own.
6. Competitors must supply their own personal sailing gear, food and drinks.

### **Rules**

1. The International Sailing Federation racing rules will govern the regatta.
2. Each boat will be sailed by a crew of 3 at least one of whom is a person of colour.
3. Competitors will be required to wear a life jacket at all times while afloat.

### **Entries and conditions of entry.**

Entries are open to any school, community organisation or yacht club team complying with the following requirements:

1. At least one member of the team must be a person of colour.
2. The sailors must be between 12 and 19 years of age. (i.e. high school going age)
3. Teams must satisfy the organising authority that they have enough experience to handle a sailing dinghy at close quarters in windy conditions.
4. All entries must be received by Friday, the 3rd of October.
5. A completed entry form must be accompanied by an indemnity form completed by each competitor's parent or guardian

## **Izivunguvungu Racing**

### **Competition format**

If more than 10 entries are received, the championship will consist of a qualifying series and a final series. Competitors will be notified which fleet they have been assigned to at the regatta registration.

### **Scoring**

Qualifying series:

If fewer than 4 races are sailed, the team's score will be sum of their race scores. If 4 or more races are completed, the team's score will be the sum of her race scores, excluding their worst race score.

Final series:

The team's overall result in the qualifying series will count as a single score in the final series. If fewer than 4 races are sailed, the team's score will be sum of their race scores. If 4 or more races are completed, the team's score will be the sum of her race scores, excluding their worst race score.

### **Notes to teams**

- You will be getting wet! Bring a change of clothing to go home in. Wear shorts, takkies and a spray top (if you have one).
- Bring a water bottle to keep on the boat. You will get thirsty between races.
- Wear sunscreen.
- Races will go ahead at the advertised times. Please ensure that you are at the Navy sailing center, dressed for sailing by 3pm sharp on Friday afternoon.
