Notice of Regatta

Venue: Pretoria Sailing Club

Date: 7, 8th and 9th August 2004

Registration: 09h00 on Saturday 7th August 2004. When registering please give indication of numbers requiring meals.

Starting time: The warning signal for the first race on Saturday the 7th August will be 10-30 hours. The times for subsequent races will be displayed on the Regatta Notice Board. An ‘L’ flag flown on the Bridge at the finish of a race will indicate a “back to back” race.
The last race will not commence after 14h00 on Monday the 9th August unless required to complete the regatta.

Rules: The regatta will be sailed under the 2001/2004 ISF Racing Rules, the SAS prescription thereto, the rules of the Finn, 505 and Sprog classes.

Eligibility: The skipper and crew of each competing yacht shall be a member of their class (if required by the class rules), and in good standing of any SAS affiliated club .

No. of races: The regatta will consist of a maximum of 12 races. A minimum of 4 races must be sailed. If only 4 races are sailed, all will count. If 5 to 7 races are sailed there will be 1 discard. If 8 or more races are sailed there will be 2 discards.

Entries: Entry fee for classes:

Entries will be accepted at the venue 1 hour prior to the start of racing.

Sailing instructions:

Sailing instructions are attached and course cards will be available from the regatta office.
Either Olympic type courses or PSC Club courses will be sailed, this will be at the discretion of the race officer. This Notice of Regatta forms part of the sailing instructions.

Scoring: The low -points scoring system, as set out in Appendix A4, A4.1 and A4.2 will apply. Ties will be broken in accordance with ISF RR Appendix A8 “Series Ties”.

Alternative Penalty:

The 720-degree penalty in terms of Rule 44.1 and 44.2 and touching a mark 360-degree penalty in accordance with rule 31 shall apply.

Access to the Club

All vehicles will be given a visitor's card at the boom at the entrance to Rietvlei Dam that must be handed back at the gate on exit. **Gate no.2 to PSC** will be open, to allow easy access to visitors.

Liability:

Competitors compete entirely at their own risk. None of the organizations or persons concerned with the running of the regatta will accept any liability for any damage or injuries that may be suffered at any time during the regatta.

Prize giving / Prize giving will take place after the last race on Monday.

Lunches, braai packs for the Saturday evening, tea, coffee and cool drinks
Bar facilities will be available lunchtime and after sailing.
Tea and coffee will be available at no charge until the start of the first race each day or until 10-30am.
