



## **NOTICE OF REGATTA**

#### **1.ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

The regatta is organized by Deneysville Aquatic Club (DAC).

#### **2.RULES**

The regatta will be sailed under the 2001/2004 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the SAS amendments, the NKA amendments, this notice of Regatta (except if any of these are amended by the Sailing Instructions), the Sailing Instructions and the rules of each class participating.

#### **3.ENTRY FEES**

The entry fee will be payable at registration prior to the start of the first race, and will be R40,00 per boat.

#### **4.SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

The warning signal for the first race will be at 12:55 on Saturday 24 January 2004. An "L" flag flown on the Bridge at the finish of a race will indicate a "back to back" race. The Warning signal of the last race will not be hoisted after 14:25 on Sunday 25 January 2004.

A maximum of 6 races are scheduled with a minimum of 3 races to constitute a regatta.

#### **5.SCORING**

The low point scoring system as provided in RRS Appendix A4 of the racing rules will apply. If only 3 races are sailed all will count. If 4 - 6 races are sailed there will be one discard.

## 6.SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & COURSES

Sailing Instructions and Course Cards will be available at the Regatta Secretary's office from 10h30 hours on Saturday 24 January 2004. The courses to be sailed will be windward leeward.

## 7.ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

For an infringement of Part 2 of the Racing Rules, RRS 44.2 (720 degree turns penalty) will apply.

## 8.SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be made available upon registration.

## 9.PRIZES

Prize giving will take place approximately one hour after the end of the last race in the DAC club house.

## 10.LIABILITY

The attention of all competitors is drawn to the fact that participation in the Regatta is entirely at their own risk and no responsibility for damage or injury resulting there from will rest with the Organizing Authority, Class Associations, DAC or any person connected with the running of the Regatta.
