1. Development and Accreditation Seminar

Following on from the previous development bulletin, as I stated, the accreditation process will be a long one. I have managed to finally confirm the date for the first facilitators symposium for the accreditation of the coaches for SA Sailing.

The South African Sports Commission will be running the course on 27,28,29 October Pretoria Sailing Club.

Each person wishing to be accredited should make every effort to attend this course. You need, as a federation to be accredited. It will be essential that at least one trainer from each region should attend, more if possible. A trainer does not need to be a top training teacher, scout masters, university students, young sailors and any person wanting to improve sailing may attend this course. Accommodation can be arranged for out of town sailors at friends' houses.

SAS will bear the cost of the actual facilitator who will run the course, but each person will be required to pay R80.00 per day for the meals and teas.

I will detail more information on what you need to bring, but in the mean time, gather information on your 'Coaching CV'. This should include time spent training, courses run, ages and abilities of pupils. Please send this information before the course. If there is no previous experience, just send your personal details, and state 'new trainer'.

More information will be sent on Thursday 9th October.
