1. **Outstanding Skippers tickets.**

The SAS offices have large numbers of skipper's ticket applications in the 'pending' file awaiting action by those who have applied for these tickets but have apparently not taken steps to produce outstanding items to complete the issuing process.

Every person on the attached lists has been contacted at least once by the SAS office but has failed to respond. While some persons may be waiting for Radio Licences, and SAS is aware of the delay in taking the tests, the most have not booked tests with the licensing authority ICASA.

In view of the poor response to the SAS offices requests, we must advise those persons listed that should no action be taken to rectify the situation by the 31st October 2004, the outstanding applications will be archived. Should those persons then require tickets at a later stage they will be invited to re-apply or pay R100.00 to retrieve the original application from archive.

2. **Outstanding Vessel Registrations.**

There are also a number of Vessel registration certificates outstanding that the office is unable to complete because vessel owners have not responded to requests to supply the requisite outstanding information to complete the process.

Here again any incomplete applications will be archived on 31 October unless SAS hears from the owners in question.

3. **Club Action.**

Yacht clubs are requested to ensure that attention is drawn to the content of this Bulletin and copies made available to its members as necessary.

The attached lists detail the outstanding items. Note that the list is in Excel and the applications are listed by club. Each club is on its own separate spreadsheet.
