**A little on terminology:**

**Interactive? Moderated? What do these mean.**

Interactive means that all users can submit news articles through easy to use form based inputs.

Moderated in that the site administrators with SAS monitor the postings received and reserve the right to remove or prohibit any submissions that are off topic as well as ban a user for abusive posts or abusing the site.

**How has this been achieved and what other benefits are there?**

By using a state of the art open source, content management system drive website. By registering with the site, the user can get access to its many features.

**If I register will my details be available to other users as in the case of the current SAS site?**

The answer is no.

In order to register, all that is required is a valid e-mail address and a username. SAS does not require any other details to register with the new site. All that is required is a valid e-mail to receive your auto generated password and username; the title that you will use when you login. Each of the main separate sites will require their own unique login. You can choose whether you want your email to be viewable by others, or not; by default it is hidden, so privacy is protected.
