In this Leaflet:

Changes to National Sanctioned Events Regulation SE-01.

In response to members suggestions SAS Council has reviewed the National Sanctioned Events Regulations (SE – 01) with a view to making event organisation less onerous. Council found that the further simplification of forms was essential and that the collection of levies was both impractical and uneconomical. Furthermore while SAS is still prepared to offer a service to collect event fees on behalf of Event Organising Authorities, there are no objections to such fees being collected by the organisers themselves.

Hence, and as from the 31st March 2005:

- The National Championship Levy of 5% previously payable in terms of paragraph 17 on Entry Fees will no longer be applicable.
- The requirement for entries to be submitted to Regional SAS offices in terms of document SE – 01 paragraph 8.1 is to be discontinued. In future, entries for National Championships may be sent directly to the Event Organising Authorities. Any requests for SAS Office assistance will be favourably considered.
- All outstanding Levies remain payable and should be submitted along with the Closure Form (SE – 07).
- Closure Forms are still required and should be submitted immediately after the conclusion of Championship Events.

Please note that the above changes do not apply to events that have already been sanctioned.

It is hoped that the above changes will achieve the objectives of simplification and practicality.
