The Championships will be governed by:

The Class Rules of the International Laser Class Association.

This Notice of Race.

The Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereof.

Where relevant, precedence shall be given in the reverse order of listing.

ENTRIES

Entries must be completed on the attached entry form and submitted together with the required entry fee to the Regatta Secretary at the address below.

Entry forms must be countersigned by a parent or guardian where the competitor will be under age of 21 years on the first day of the regatta.

Telephonic or incomplete entries will not be accepted.

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES

Payment may be made by cash or cheque or bank deposit to the credit of the account detail below on Entry Form. In the case of deposits made to the said bank account, the bank stamp deposit note or the printed electronic transaction note **and** the completed entry form shall be either mailed or transmitted by fax simultaneously to the Regatta secretary. The deposit document shall state the event and entrants name.

REGISTRATION

Entries shall be confirmed by registration with the Regatta Secretary at the venue commencing 18:00 on 19th March to 20:00 and continuing from 08:00 on the 20th March until one hour prior to the start of the first race.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available from the Regatta Secretary at the regatta venue upon registration.

GENERAL

The First Race of the championship is scheduled to start at 11:00 on Saturday 20th March 2010

No warning signal will be made after 14:00 on the last day of racing.

RACING AREA and COURSES

Racing will take place offshore Mossel Bay.

The courses to be sailed will be set out in the sailing instructions.

SAFETY

Yachts shall comply with their class buoyancy and safety requirements.

All competitors shall wear a personal buoyancy aid at all times while afloat in a yacht.

Wet or Dry suits do not constitute personal buoyancy.

SCORING SYSTEM

The low / bonus points scoring system, RRS A4 will apply.

When four races or fewer have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding one worst score for every five races.

LIABILITY

Participation in this event is entirely at the risk of competitors and no responsibility for damage or injury resulting therefrom will rest with the organising authority, class associations, or any person concerned with the conduct of the regatta.
